"Knowing our neighbours creates a community, provides a sense of belonging and gives reassurance there will always be someone to help out in a crisis, disaster or emergency.

"During February's bushfire infernos across regional Victoria and the floods through northern NSW and North Queensland we really saw how vital neighbours are to each other.

"Ordinary Australians coming together to lend each other a hand.

"That's why getting together with our neighbours creates vibrant, healthy communities. It breaks down the barriers of loneliness and isolation experienced by the elderly and other people who live alone.

"In doing so we make our suburbs and towns safer, happier places to live and raise a family," said Andrew.

It's easy to participate in Neighbour Day and you don't have to register or make a donation.

- ✓ Make a special effort to introduce yourself to older residents in your street and anyone who lives alone.
- ✓ Leave your mobile and home telephone number for their use in an emergency.
